PROGRAM PROCEDURES

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- Applicant must be a primary member (first owner named on the account) in good standing with Blackhawk Community Credit Union.
- Applicant must be a 2026 graduating senior from a high school or home school from within the communities we serve.
- Applicant must be planning to attend an accredited public or private college, community college or technical college. Awards will not be disbursed until the student is accepted and enrolled in an accredited institution.
- Previous winners are not eligible for the BHCCU Scholarship Program.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Please ensure all submitted files - including your application, transcript, and video/essay/poster - are labeled with your full name.

Applicant must submit:

Completed application including a listing of all Volunteer & Community Involvement, Awards & Honors,
Extracurricular & Leadership Activities, and a brief description of how you balance your responsibilities
(school, work, community, and personal life).

- ☐ A high school transcript that includes your GPA from the end of the most recent school year.
- ☐ Bring your story to life in the way that suits you best! Choose one of the following creative formats to answer this question: "What's your favorite part of your community, and why is it special to you?" Think about a place, event or tradition that truly captures what you love about where you live. Share why it matters, maybe it's helped you grow, brought people together, or made you feel more connected to those around you.
- ☐ Pick one way to express what your community means to you:
 - 1. Submit a short video (up to 3 minutes)
 - 2. Write a creative, heartfelt essay (max 2 pages)
 - 3. Design a visual poster that speaks volumes

All application materials must be uploaded by midnight on February 15, 2026 to **www.bhccu.org**. Application materials can be uploaded by scrolling to the bottom of the homepage and clicking on the "secure file upload" link. Fill out the secure upload form and attach your application materials. Late and incomplete entries will not be accepted.

BHCCU has the right to amend any of the above rules to ensure fairness in the awarding of the scholarships.

ADMINISTRATIVE/AWARD PROCEDURES:

Scholarship funds will be paid only to the school's business office. Funds are to be used in the 2026-27 school year for tuition or books. Any funds not used for these purposes will be forfeited. In January of each year, BHCCU is required to file form 1099 with the IRS, which reports amounts paid to reduce student loans during the previous year. The student will be mailed a copy of Form 1099 and may be required to report on a tax return any scholarship winnings applied to student loans. We recommend that the student consult a tax advisor.

JUDGING:

A panel of impartial judges will make final decisions. All decisions are final.

The scholarship committee will assess applications based on:

Community Involvement, Leadership & Initiative, Well-Roundedness, Effort & Quality, Academic Readiness

Judging Criteria for Essays, Videos, or Posters:

Community Connection, Personal Impact, Creativity, Emotional Impact, Clarity & Focus, Presentation
